## How to use Environmental Records Viewer (ERV)

The Environmental Records Viewer (ERV) is a web-based tool that allows the public to access and visualize data and authorizations. The ERV supports searches for:

- Pesticide registrations issued under the *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act* (*EPEA*).
- Waste Management notifications and registrations issued under the *Environmental Protection* and *Enhancement Act (EPEA)*.
- Water Act licences and applications in a particular location, or search for licences and licence applications that meet a set of criteria.

The ERV aligns with the GOA digital and data strategies, with a focus on Data Accessibility and Sharing. Please note that with the ERV under development, the user experience may change as additional types of authorizations are made available and functions are updated.
